- Company name
- Email address
- Phone number
- Postal address (if provided)
- Message content

project related data

- Creative briefs
- Files, images, and materials submitted by clients
- Production-related communication
- Project documentation

4. purpose of data processing

We process personal data for the following purposes:

- Operating and maintaining the website
- Responding to inquiries
- Managing client projects (film & photo production)
- Communication and collaboration
- Security and technical stability
- Statistical analysis and improvement of services
- Legal compliance

5. cookies & tracking technologies

We use cookies and similar technologies to:

- Analyze website traffic
- Optimize content and performance

Users may disable cookies in their browser settings at any time.

6. third party services

We may use third-party services, including:

7. data sharing

Personal data is only shared when:

- required by law

8. data retention

Data is retained only as long as necessary for the intended purpose or legal obligations.
